Please make checks for tuition payable to *St. Matthew School*. Envelopes will be provided for tuition payments and can be picked up at the parish office or at the school. Envelopes can be sent directly to the parish office, deposited in the Sunday collection, or dropped off at the school office. We are offering families the option of payment by credit card (in the parish office) or by automatic debit from your bank. Please fill out an ACH form if you want to pay tuition in this manner. **The first tuition payment is due August 15.**

Effective for the 2009-2010 school year, the discount for Annual or Semi-Annual payments will only be available for balances paid in full by the deadline in August and January. If payment is not received by the deadline, then the payment schedule will revert to 10 equal monthly payments. In addition, a monthly fee of \$15 will be assessed for returned payments or late payments received after the 15th of the month.

The St. Matthew Parish Finance Council would like to remind all members of the parish, particularly those with students enrolled in St. Matthew School, that being a “parishioner” includes more than simply registering with the parish office. All parishioners, as members of the Body of Christ, are expected to regularly (i.e., weekly) participate in the sacramental and liturgical life at St. Matthew Church as well as to exercise good stewardship by sharing their time, talents, and resources with the parish community. For parishioners, membership in the parish is primary. Therefore, please make the \$400.00 minimum contribution—or anything over the minimum you freely give—a priority. **This contribution needs to be made by May 1, 2010.** Thank you.
